



THE ADA & BERTIE LEVENSTEIN BURSARY

Bursary opportunity for UJ Postgraduate students whose financial circumstances preclude them from pursuing their studies

- Applicants must be South African citizens between the ages of 18 (eighteen) and 25 (twenty-five);
- An applicant may not concurrently hold this support with another scholarship or fund (s) from any other source;
- An applicant must currently be registered for a postgraduate degree in the field of Science such as medicine, engineering, or information technology;
- Applicants have a proven financial need based on being a member of a household with a gross combined income of not more than R 600 000 (six hundred thousand Rand) per annum;
- Applicants shall provide an academic record indicating an overall average of sixty (60%) Percent or above in the preceding semester and year of study and shall be required to maintain an academic performance level as set out aforementioned;
- The student having been granted a bursary shall only be eligible for a bursary in the succeeding year provided that they have been successful in passing all examinations in the preceding year.
