



FULLY ONLINE PROGRAMMES PAYMENT METHODS

IMPORTANT:

- Full payment for the intended intake's module(s) must be made and cleared before a student can commence with the registration process.
- International payments may take longer to clear than normal.
- International students are not required to pay the international levy.
- All previous debt with UJ must first be settled before a student will be allowed to register for a fully online programme.
- Bad debt written off does not mean the student is now exonerated from the debt. Full payment still needs to be made before a student will be allowed to register.

Credit Card Payments (**PREFERRED METHOD**)

- ✓ To make an online E-payments (credit card) please click [HERE](#).
- Credit card payments will reflect on your UJ student account **immediately**.

Bank Deposits

- ✓ Visit your closest FNB Branch.
- ✓ Select the **UJ Tuition Fees Account** (available as a predefined beneficiary) for payment.
- ✓ Always use your valid **UJ student number** as reference.
- Bank deposits from FNB to FNB will reflect on your UJ student account within **15 minutes**.
- Bank deposits from any other back to FNB may take up to **3 working days** to reflect on your UJ student account.

EFT Payments

- ✓ The FNB ***UJ Tuition Fees Account*** is available as a predefined beneficiary on all electronic platforms of all major banks, including Capitec Bank.
- ✓ Search for the predefined beneficiary (***UJ Tuition Fees Account***) on your electronic banking platform.
- ✓ Select and save the FNB ***UJ Tuition Fees Account*** as a beneficiary and complete payment.
- ✓ Always use your valid ***UJ student number*** as reference.
- EFT's from FNB to FNB will reflect on your UJ student account within **15 minutes**.
- EFT's from any other bank to FNB may take up to **72 hours** to reflect on your UJ student account.
- EFT's made from outside the country borders may take longer to clear. It is recommended that foreign students make payment at least **ten working days** before the registration period closes.

ATM Deposits

- ✓ Use any **FNB** cash accepting ATM – *FNB only*.
- ✓ Select the cardless services option on the ATM and deposit the cash.
- ✓ Under FNB Recipient Name, key in UJ and then space. The ***UJ Tuition Fees Account*** will appear for you to select.
- ✓ Always use your valid ***UJ student number*** as reference.
- ATM payments made at an FNB ATM will reflect on your UJ student account within **15 minutes**.
- ATM payments made at any other bank to FNB may take up to **3 working days** to reflect on your UJ student account

Debit/Credit Card Payments

Debit/Credit cards are only accepted if you pay in person at the UJ Student Finance departments available on each campus.
