

CALL FOR THE MOBILITY OF STUDENTS WITHIN THE ERASMUS+ KA171 PROGRAMME FOR THE PERIOD 01/06/2025 TO 30/11/2027

University of Johannesburg is launching a call for the mobility of students for the purpose of studying/training at the University of Nova Gorica, Slovenia

Erasmus+ is the EU programme that supports activities in the fields of education, training, youth and sports. The purpose of the programme:

The Erasmus+ programme enables students at the University of Johannesburg to complete part of the study obligations of the enrolled programme at any level of study at the University of Nova Gorica (UNG) according to the signed interinstitutional agreement between UCT and UNG.

The student can select one the following mobility types:

- 1) **Semester(s)** The student should select this mobility type if she/he is applying to undertake a **long-term study mobility** abroad with a duration from **2 months to 12 months**. *The student also has the option to add a virtual component to the study mobility before, during or after. If the student uses this option, she/he must also select the virtual component as part of the mobility type.*
- 2) **Blended mobility with short-term physical mobility** The student should select this mobility type if she/he is applying to undertake a short-term physical mobility at UNG of 5-30 days by combining it with a compulsory virtual component.
- 3) **Short-term doctoral mobility** Doctoral Candidates should select this mobility type when they are applying to undertake a short-term physical mobility of 5-30 days. *Optionally, the Doctoral Candidate also has the option to add a virtual component to the study mobility before, during or after. If the student uses this option, she/he must also select the virtual component as part of the mobility type.*

ERASMUS+ FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Amount of financial support for individual student is:

- **Individual financial Erasmus dotation: 800 EUR / month (30 days) for long-term mobility / 79 EUR daily up to and including the 14th day of the physical mobility and 56 EUR daily from 15th day onwards for short-term mobility (5-30 days)**
- Travel support: based on the distance (1.735 EUR for travel from Johannesburg)
- Financial support for visa and health insurance up to 250 EUR
- Priority will be given to students from the environment with fewer opportunities. A student with fewer opportunities is a student who:
 - holds a decision on accompanying person, tailored modes of schooling, disability benefits
 - is included in the special-needs education scheme
 - comes from low income family and is recipient of university subsidy
 - comes from a single-parent or foster family
 - is from a family in which one of the children or parents is holding a decision on disability benefits
 - has been granted international protection
 - is a representative of a minority community

In case the student will circle any of the above-mentioned conditions, the student will be required to submit a relevant proof in the form of an attachment to student application.

The student who applies for this call will be subsequently informed of all further procedures, additional funding and linguistic preparation by the Erasmus+ institutional coordinator to the e-mail address provided in the application.

BASIC CONDITIONS FOR APPLYING TO THE CALL

A student of the University of Johannesburg who meets the following conditions may apply to the call:

- is enrolled in at least the second year of the first-stage studies while studying abroad;
- has an active student status at UJ throughout his/her studies abroad;
- is enrolled in a Physics, Mathematics, or Computer Science degree;

CONTENT OF THE APPLICATION TO THE CALL

A student wishing to apply to the call is to submit a complete application with the following forms or documents enclosed:

- the application form attached to this call;
- a letter of motivation in English, which must also show courses that the student wants to take at the partner institution indicated in the application (at least one and no more than two pages);
- proof of the average grade of all exams passed before applying to the call.

METHOD OF AND DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION

The deadline for submitting is open until funds for mobility are available, but priority will be given to applications received by **01/06/2025**.

The application must be sent to the Erasmus+ institutional coordinator of the UJ in an electronic format to: **capp@uj.ac.za**

The Erasmus+ institutional coordinator of the UJ will not consider incomplete applications - they will be returned to the sender.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Opening and checking the basic fulfilment requirements of the applications to the call as well as the formal examination of the applications will be performed by the Erasmus+ institutional coordinator of the UJ.

Applications from the applicants who do not meet the basic conditions for applying to the call will be rejected.

The application will be assessed based on a motivation letter (0 to 10 points) and the average grade of all exams (0 to 10 points). A priority list of candidates for each host institution will be drawn up based on the points achieved and the availability of places at the host institution (UNG).

The Erasmus+ institutional coordinator at UJ will draw up a priority list of candidates for the allocation of financial support and forward it to the University of Nova Gorica for final approval of candidates.

If the European Commission or the National Agency (Centre of the Republic of Slovenia for Mobility and European Education and Training Programmes) does not approve sufficient funds for the implementation of all applied mobilities, priority will be given to higher year students

Students will be notified of their application by the Erasmus+ institutional coordinator via the e-mail address provided in the application.
