

UJ ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMME (UJELP)

Purpose

The University of Johannesburg English Language Programme (UJELP) offers intensive language lab sessions to international students, focusing on English language skills in speaking, listening, reading, and writing. The program is divided into six levels, each lasting five weeks, aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

English Proficiency Requirements

All prospective undergraduate or postgraduate international students who have not studied in English or foreign nationals who would like to learn English are invited to participate in the course.

UJELP offers a proficiency test (Placement Tests) and English as a Foreign Language (EFL) course.

Course Structure

The EFL course is divided into three modules over 10 weeks.

NQF level 4 qualification or equivalent experience.

- 2. Register for the course
