1. Certified ID Copy
2. Matric Certificate/Statement of results (for first-year applicants)
3. Latest tertiary academic record (for second or subsequent years)
4. Proof of acceptance from your tertiary institution (for both first year and returning students)
5. Certified Parents'/Guardians' ID documents
6. Parents'/Guardians' proof of income (latest payslip etc.)
