FINANCIAL & CONTRACTUAL

- 1. Is my residence POSA accredited?
- 2. What is POSA, how can they assist students and what are their implications on off campus residences?
- 3. What is a lease agreement?
- 4. What is the duration of the lease and the policy on renewing the lease for upcoming years?
- 5. Is it NSFAS accredited and are there any extra fees or hidden costs beyond the NSFAS rate (upfront deposit or top up)?
- 6. Are you allowed to change accommodation during the year and what is the process?
- 7. Are there costs associated with parking facilities or laundry?
- 8. What is the policy on sharing accommodation with others (cash backs)?
- 9. What is the policy on day and night visitors?
- 10. Does one have to pay individually for amenities (WIFI, electricity and water) within the residence or they are included in the NSFAS rate?
- 11. In case of plugs or light bulbs burnouts, does the student have to replace them out of their own pocket money?
- 12. In case a student loses the keys, should they replace them out of their own pocket money?
